Then I'd circle to the goat pen and pick out a big blue Billy goat to nurse that warm beer, like it was milk, through a rubber calf nipple. Then I'd run around to the front and take bets from the other kids on which goat would get roped first. The gun would fire, the gate would fly open, and sure as hell my drunk blue Billy-goat could barely stagger out from in front of the herd of young'uns slinging their lassos and yelling like a house a-fire. I could quite honestly clear \$25 a day hoodwinking those little 4H'ers. They never figured out how that skinny kid from Ola could pick the slowest rodeo goat every time.
